- 9 year old dog = 52 year old human
- 10 year old dog = 56 year old human
- 11 year old dog = 60 year old human
- 12 year old dog = 64 year old human
- 13 year old dog = 68 year old human
- 14 year old dog = 72 year old human
- 15 year old dog = 76 year old human



Did you know the K9 nose is perhaps a million times more sensitive than the human nose!

Ensure your companion is safe and well this summer.

Fly Bites: Some dogs are bothered by flies that bite their ears. In severe infestations, the flies cover the ears and leave behind bloody bite marks that seem to be irritating and can become infected. You can use a variety of salves, insect repellents, and insecticides to kill the flies or keep them away.

Avoid Heat Stress:

- Access to fresh cool water all the time.
- Shade
- Not to be left in confined hot areas. (like a car)
- Sunscreen and fly repellent
- Good ventilation
- Exercise in the cool of day.

PREVENTION IS ALWAYS BETTER THAN CURE.

Bones: pet owners will make the mistake of feeding the left over BBQ bones and Christmas dinner to their K9 companions. This can cause many different complaints and sever discomfort. Raw bones are great fed once or twice weekly to assist with dental and gum hygiene. Everything in moderation.

Signs of Heat Stress:

- Obvious distress
- Severe panting
- Exhaustion
- Collapse
- Convulsions and fitting
- Very hot to touch

Emergency Treatment:

Seek veterinary attention immediately.

Cool with wet towel's and hose.
